Members are welcome to invite guests and costs will be as follows:

For the coach only - £18 for members and £20 for non-member guests.

For the coach plus entry to the Open Exhibition - £24.50 for members and £26.50 for guests. The entry fee of £6.50 is a block booking/paid in advance rate.

Some members may have RWA or other membership that allows free entry to the exhibition and should pay for the coach only and use their pass at the door.

The coach has a capacity for 53 and spare places will be offered to other art societies in due course. The coach has a toilet and wi-fi. There will be a comfort stop on the way.
